Nomination Details (continued)

Note: Please ensure the nomination complies with the following conditions:

- a) Nominations may only be for one category however, evidence supporting the nomination covering activities relevant to the other categories should be provided and will be taken into consideration. It is important that the complete career of the nominee is put forward to permit a total assessment.
- b) Nominees are to be in good standing with SLSA. Controversy should be avoided e.g. persons charged with using performance-enhancing drugs, for example, or who have been found guilty of criminal offences (whether connected with SLSA or not) should not be nominated.
- c) Nominations should draw names from a broad range of members or teams who have been, or are currently:
 - Office holders and administrators
 - Competition Officials
 - Patrolling members
 - Rescue Services groups
 - Coaches
 - Examiners
 - Competitors
 - Advisors (e.g. medical)
- d) Nominations must clearly demonstrate that individuals or teams have:
 - (i) displayed exceptional service to surf lifesaving in the specific category;
 - (ii) achieved outstanding individual or team accomplishments which sets the individual or team apart from other surf lifesavers or teams;
 - (iii) displayed sustained excellence over a long period of time to the category for which they are nominated.
