

## **APPLICATION FORM FOR CHIEF REFEREES AND DEPUTY REFEREES TO OFFICIATE AT RESCUE 2010: NEWQUAY, CORNWELL, GREAT BRITAIN**

Applications are invited from all experienced and suitably qualified persons who wish to be considered for appointment for one or more of the positions of Chief Referee and Deputy Referee for Rescue 2010, the World Lifesaving Championships, to be held at Newquay, Cornwall, England, in July 2010.

If you wish to be considered, please complete this form and submit it to the Chairman: Event Management Committee, ILS Sports Commission **by 3<sup>rd</sup> January, 2009**. Appointments will be made by the ILS Sport Commission, at their meeting at the end of January, 2009. All applicants will be advised if they have been successful or not. Also all receipts of applications forms will be acknowledged.

Chief Referees and Deputy Referees are required for the following World Championships:

- National Team Pool Championships
- InterClub Pool Championships
- Masters Pool Championships
- National Teams Simulated Emergency Response Competition Championships
- InterClub Simulated Emergency Response Competition Championships
- National Teams Ocean and Beach Championships
- InterClub Ocean and Beach Championships
- Masters Ocean and Beach Championships
- Surf Boat Championships
- IRB Championships

Potential applicants may apply for one or more positions, however, at this stage no detail programme for Rescue 2010 is available yet, however the Championships will be held in early July, 2010. All events, that is pool, ocean and beach will be held at Fristral Beach, Newquay, Cornwall, Great Britain. Please note that some events – such as Masters Pool and National Teams Ocean, Interclub Pool and Surf Boat and/or IRB may be run simultaneously.

Applicants for the position of Chief Referee should have extensive experience - at least have officiated in the position of Chief Referee in at least 3 international events. International events are events where at least three nations or more are competing, such as a Regional Championship (like the European Championships), German Cup, World Games, International Surf Rescue Challenge, Commonwealth Championships, TriNations, and as well the applicant should have officiated in the position as Chief Referee at 3 National Championships.

Applicants for the position of Deputy Referee should have extensive experience - at least have officiated in the position of Deputy Referee in at least 3 international events. International events are events where at least three or more nations are competing, such as a Regional Championship (like the European Championships), German Cup, Commonwealth Championships, World Games, International Surf Rescue Challenge, TriNations, and as well the applicant should have officiated in the position as Chief Referee at 1 National Championship.

The minimum requirement in terms of qualifications is that the candidate should have the qualification of a level 3 official in his/her Federation for at least 5 years.

The Chief Referee is required to undertake the following:

- In conjunction with the ILS Sport Commission and Local Rescue 2010 Organising Committee (LOC) assist in the appointment of officials for their respective Championships.
- Advise the LOC on the detail event programme of their respective Championships.
- Check event draws for their respective Championships.
- Attend and conduct the briefing of officials, coaches and athletes for their respective Championships.
- Hold the position as Chief Referee and undertake all duties as set out in the ILS Competition Manual of their respective Championships.
- Submit a report on their respective Championships at the conclusion of the event.

The Deputy Referee is required to undertake the following:

- Hold the position as Deputy Referee and undertake all duties as set out in the ILS Competition Manual of their respective Championships.
- Assist the Referee where required.

In terms of the contract between ILS and the host for Rescue 2010 – Surf Lifesaving Association of Great Britain, it was agreed that travel and accommodation be provided for 6 International Referees. The ILS Sport Commission and the LOC will decide which Referees qualify for the travel and accommodation. The remainder of the appointed Referees and Deputy Referees will be responsible for their own travel and

accommodation, to be paid for either by the individual concerned or their National Federation that nominates the individual. No additional expenses – apart for the 6 Referees - are provided for by the Local Organising Committee of Rescue 2010, Surf Lifesaving Association of Great Britain or ILS.

The ILS Sport Commission will seek endorsement from the applicants National Federation and will verify the information supplied, before any appointment is confirmed.
