Introduction of the Ski Leg into the Masters Ironwomen Race

Summary

This bulletin confirms SLSA's decision to introduce the surf ski leg into Masters Ironwomen events up to and including the 45 -49 year age category effective from the date of this bulletin.

This Bulletin also advises that the ski leg will be introduced for the older age groups effective from the commencement of the 2009/10 season.

For some years International Life Saving (ILS) has included the surf ski leg in Masters Ironwomen events. At the 2008 Australian Surf Life Saving Championships some Masters competitors approached the SLSA Surf Sports Rules Technical Committee to promote the introduction of the surf Ski leg into the Masters Ironwomen events conducted by SLSA.

Following consultation within SLSA it was agreed to implement the change so that in the 2008/09 season the Masters Ironwomen events shall include the ski leg for all age groups up to and including 45 -49 years i.e. immediate introduction for the following age groups:

30 - 34 years
35 - 39 years
40 - 45 years
45 - 49 years

Further to this the ski leg will be introduced for the older age groups effective from the commencement of the 2009/10 season. This will enable one season's notice for the introduction of this change for following age groups:

50 - 54 years
55 years plus
