Summary

This circular contains the names of Officials appointed for the 2009 Interstate Championships to be held on Wednesday the 18th of March 2009 at Scarborough Beach, Western Australia. All relevant reporting details and other matters for notation by appointed Officials are also enclosed.

The 2009 Australian Interstate Championships will be held in conjunction with the 2009 Whereis[®] Australian Surf Life Saving Championships. As such Officials should note that they may be requested to work in positions or areas across both Championships and should refer to Circular 45/08-09 *2009 Whereis[®] Australian Surf Life Saving Championships Officials Appointment Schedule* for further information.

Please note that it is mandatory for all appointed Officials to attend all briefings relevant to their appointment and to the Australian Interstate Championships.

The Interstate Officials Briefing will be held at the Scarboro SLSC at 7.45am on Wednesday 18 March 2009 prior to competition starting at 9.00am. Further timetable details will be promulgated in due course.

COMPETITION CONDITIONS

All appointed Officials should obtain a copy of current Competition Manuals and Bulletins and make themselves familiar with the current detailed procedures as available on the SLSA website, www.slsa.com.au.

CATERING

Breakfast will be provided to Officials at the Official's Briefing Area at Scarboro SLSC from 6.00am on Wednesday 18 March 2009.

As per previous years, lunches and on beach drinks will be provided for Officials. These will be distributed under the direction of the Sectional Referees. At the completion of activities on this day, refreshments will be available at the Official's Briefing Area at Scarboro SLSC.

DRESS OF OFFICIALS

It is imperative that the appearance of appointed Officials is of a standard befitting the event (Surf Sports Manual, Manual No 3, 33rd Edition September 2008, Clause 13.4). Therefore, appointed Officials are requested to give detailed attention to their appearance. Dress shall be neat white shorts / skirt **or** optional navy blue shorts / skirt with the white shirt / Championships shirts that is distributed at the event.

NOTE: SLSA would like to remind all Officials to bring a refillable water bottle that they can refill with water that will be made available.

NOTE: No sponsor or other identification other than the SLSA logo is permitted on any Officials clothing, hats, etc. Notwithstanding the foregoing, sponsored shirts etc, maybe made available for issue to carnival Officials who will be expected to wear these garments.

APPOINTMENTS

The appointment of Officials is a consultative process involving the Director of Surf Sports, the Carnival Referee and the Competition Officials Advisor, and when appointed the Area Referees are included in the final consultation. All appointments emanate from nominations received and endorsed by the respective States and National bodies. These appointments are based upon Official's competencies as assessed periodically.

HEALTH AND FITNESS OF OFFICIALS

After advice received from the Cancer Council, it is stressed that all Officials be adequately protected from the sun to avoid over exposure. The wearing of appropriate Official's clothing and the wide-brim hats provided plus the application of recognised sun protection creams and lotions is strongly advised.

All Officials are advised that it is essential that they bring their national Official's accredited name bars and license.
