Summary

The appointment of officials for the Sydney 2009 World Masters Games was a consultative process involving the Referee and Surf Sports Officials Appointments & Welfare Advisor. All appointments are derived from nominations received and are based upon Officials' competencies as assessed periodically.

NOTE: Depending on resource needs some Officials may be requested to work in positions or areas other than those listed in this circular. Such Officials will be advised during the course of competition.

DRESS OF OFFICIALS

All Games participants including: competitors, team personnel, volunteers, accompanying persons, team sport umpires/referees and technical officials require an accreditation pass.

Competitors, team personnel and team sport umpires/referees will need to collect their accreditation pass from The Games Centre and will then be able to collect their Games backpack, access public transport, allocated seating at the Opening Ceremony, and officiate at the Games.

All personnel working for the Sydney 2009 World Masters Games are provided with a Games uniform, an accreditation pass and lanyard. The Games uniform will consist of various items such as a polo shirt, jacket, pants/shorts, cap, poncho and drink bottle and is designed for visibility, comfort and Games recognition.

Each volunteer (and official) will receive an accreditation pass with lanyard that is specific to them, their role and their venue. Uniforms and accreditation passes are required to be worn for each rostered shift performed during the Games period.



Photo identification, which includes your full name and date of birth (eg driver's licence, passport, student card, proof of age card), is required when collecting the accreditation pass and uniform.
