Summary

The following circular outlines the process for the collection of old patrol uniforms and where clubs can purchase extra patrol uniforms.

With the assistance of major partners DHL, Telstra and Westpac, Surf Life Saving Australia has supplied new patrol shirts and shorts to all clubs.

By now your club should have received their allocation of new patrol uniforms. For essential information on these new patrol uniforms please refer to SLSA circular 24/09-10.

OLD PATROL UNIFORMS
